**Distribution and Habitat:** Found through out the plains of India, Assam, Western Peninsula, Myanmar and Nepal. **Botany:** Spreading tree, branches rough and scarred, young parts very silky, bark grey

- *Leaves:* Alternate, deciduous petiole long, broadly winged, at times, ½ amplexicaul, older portion glabrous but younger silky pubescent, lamina simple, oblong lanceolate, strongly serrate
- *Inflorescence:* Umbels axillary and contains 5-8 flowers; flowers yellow, 2.5 cm in diameter
- *Fruit*: Globose, formed of thickened calyx enclosing indehiscent carpels.

Properties: Cooling agent, and laxative

**Chemical constituents:** Stem bark-betulin, betulinic acid, lupeol, morolic acid. Stem contains flavonone glyceride. **Uses:** Bark as ingredient of medicine for carbuncle, fistula, inter coastal neuralgia, pleurisy, pneumonia and sore.

**Propagation**: By seeds
