Distribution and habitat: Throughout West coast, near the sea and India. **Botany:** A shrub with stem and branches stout.

• *Leaves :* Large band fleshy, 7.5-12.5 cm, alternate, silky or glabrousent, tufted in the axils.

• *Flowers* : White in colour, cymes axillary, much shorter than the leaves; bracts small. Corolla-tube narrow, pubescent; lobes lanceolate. Indusium of the stigmaceliate.

• Drupe: sub-spherical, very succulent.

Uses: Sore eyes, anti tumour, carminative, anti- inflammatory, tuberculosis etc
