Distribution and habitat: Naturalized and wild in tropical parts of India, Bangladesh and Pakistan **Botany:** A medium sized tree.

• *Leaves*: Alternate, petioled, paripinnate with 5-17 pairs of leaflets.

• *Flowers:* Small. Berries cucumber shaped, greenish yellow, 5-lobed, about 50 mm long, sour and juicy, few flattened seeded.

Uses: The fruit is astringent, stomachic, refrigerant. Fruit in the form of curry is useful in piles and scurvy.

Propagation: By seeds, stem cuttings
