**Distribution and habitat:** Dry places of Malabar and Travancore, Deccan and Coimbatore. **Botany:** A very prickly small shrub; branches hairy.

• *Leaves:* broadly elliptic, obtuse, mucronate, hairy beneath, deciduously scabrid pubescent above; petioles hardly any. Bracteoles simple spines, usually long.

• *Flowers:* axillary sessile, two outer sepals large ovate subspinose, denticulate, softly hairy. Corolla purple.

• Fruit: Capsule four seeded. Uses: Cough and inflammations. Formulations: Saha cheradi kashayam Propagation: Cuttings
